DIRECTIONS

Ithaca Foreign Car Service is located at 501 West State Street, the corner of State and South Corn Streets.

Albany and points East:

Take I-90 west to I-68. Continue on I-68 to Exit 6 for State Rte. 206 at Bainbridge, NY. Head west on State Rte. 206 for 25 miles to State Rte. 79 at Whitney Point, NY. Continue west on State Rte. 79 for 26 miles, which will take you directly into Ithaca, NY. State Rte. 79 becomes State Street. Follow the State Street detour on to E. Seneca Street. Continue west on E. Seneca Street and take a left onto N. Corn. Ithaca Foreign Car Sales will be one block up on the right. *Approximate travel time from downtown Albany - 3 hr. 15 minutes*

Syracuse and points North:

Take I-61 south to Exit 12 at Corland/Homer. Then take Rte. 201 south to State Rte. 13. Continue south on State Rte. 13, which will take you into Ithaca. Take a left onto W. State Street, Ithaca Foreign Car Sales will be two blocks up on the right. *Approximate travel time from downtown Syracuse- 1hr. 15 minutes*

Rochester and points west:

Take I-90 East to Exit 42. Continue south on Rt. 14 approximately 14 mile to Rte. 96. Continue south on Rte. 96, which will take you into Ithaca. Continue straight onto W. Buffalo Street. Take a right onto N. Corn Street, Ithaca Foreign Car Sales will be two blocks up on the right. *Approximate travel time from downtown Rochester 1hr 50minutes*


Binghamton and points South:

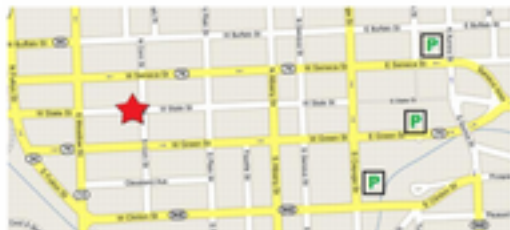
Take I-61 north to Exit 7 for State Rte. 11. Continue north to State Rt. 79 at Whitney Point. Continue west on State Rte. 79, which will take you directly into Ithaca, NY. State Rte. 79 becomes State Street. Follow the State Street detour on to E. Seneca Street. Continue west on E. Seneca Street and take a left onto N. Corn. Ithaca Foreign Car Sales will be one block up on the right. *Approximate travel time from downtown Binghamton 90 minutes*
